Malachian Bill of Rights

Article I: Freedom and Equality

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall enjoy freedom and equality before the law, and shall be entitled to equal protection and treatment under the law, without discrimination based on race, ethnicity, religion, gender, or any other status.
- 2. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to life, liberty, and security of person, and shall not be deprived of these rights except by due process of law.
- 3. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to freedom of thought, conscience, religion, and belief, and shall be free to practice and express their beliefs, subject only to the limits necessary to protect the rights and freedoms of others.

Article II: Freedom of Expression and Assembly

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to freedom of expression and opinion, and shall be free to express their views and ideas through speech, writing, art, and other means of communication.
- 2. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to freedom of peaceful assembly and association, and shall be free to form and join organizations, groups, and movements, subject only to the limits necessary to protect public order and security.

Article III: Right to Privacy

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to privacy, and shall be free from arbitrary or unlawful interference with their private life, family, home, or correspondence.
- 2. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to access and control their personal information, and shall be protected against unauthorized access, use, or disclosure of their personal data.

Article IV: Right to Fair Trial

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to a fair and impartial trial, and shall be presumed innocent until proven guilty.
- 2. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to due process of law, and shall be entitled to legal representation, access to evidence, and a hearing before an independent and competent tribunal.

Article V: Right to Education

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to education, and shall be free to choose their educational path, subject only to the limits necessary to protect public order and morals.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall provide free and compulsory primary education, and shall ensure equal access to higher education and vocational training.

Article VI: Right to Health

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to health, and shall be entitled to access to quality health care and services, including preventive, curative, and rehabilitative care.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to health, and shall ensure the availability, affordability, and accessibility of essential medicines, vaccines, and medical technologies.

Article VII: Right to Property

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to own, use, and dispose of their property, and shall be protected against arbitrary or unlawful deprivation of their property.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to property, and shall ensure the fair and equitable distribution and use of natural resources and public goods.

Article VIII: Right to Work

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to work, and shall be free to choose their profession or occupation, subject only to the limits necessary to protect public order and morals.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to work, and shall ensure equal opportunities and treatment in employment, including fair wages, safe working conditions, and social security.

Article IX: Right to Cultural Expression

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to participate in cultural life, and shall be free to express, preserve, and develop their cultural identity and heritage.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the diversity of cultural expressions, and shall ensure the access and participation of all citizens in cultural activities and events.

Article X: Right to Information

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to access information, and shall be free to seek, receive, and impart information and ideas through any media or technology, subject only to the limits necessary to protect the rights and freedoms of others.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to information, and shall ensure the transparency, accountability, and accessibility of public information and data.

Article XI: Right to Travel

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to travel freely within and outside the territory of the Malachian Empire, subject only to the limits necessary to protect public order and security.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to travel, and shall ensure that its citizens have access to necessary travel documents, such as passports and visas.
- 3. The Malachian Empire shall not arbitrarily or unlawfully restrict the right to travel of its citizens, and shall not impose unjustifiable restrictions or conditions on their movement and residence, including through discriminatory practices or policies.

Article XII: Right to Environment

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to a healthy and sustainable environment, and shall be protected against environmental degradation, pollution, and harm.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to environment, and shall ensure the conservation and sustainable use of natural resources and ecosystems.

Article XIII: Right to Rest and Leisure

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to rest and leisure, and shall be entitled to adequate time for rest, recreation, and cultural activities.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to rest and leisure, and shall ensure that its citizens have access to opportunities for rest and leisure, including holidays, vacations, and cultural events.

Article XIV: Right to Social Security

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire that wish to maintain contracts within the United States shall have the right to social security, and shall be entitled to protection against economic and social risks, such as unemployment, illness, disability, and old age.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to social security, and shall ensure the availability and accessibility of social security programs and services, including social insurance, social assistance, and other forms of support.

Article XV: Right to Political Participation

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to participate in the political life of the state, and shall be entitled to vote and stand for election, subject only to the limits necessary to protect public order and morals.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to political participation, and shall ensure equal opportunities and treatment in the exercise of political rights and freedoms.

Article XVI: Right to Access Justice

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to access justice, and shall be entitled to a fair and effective judicial system that upholds the rule of law and protects their rights and freedoms.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to access justice, and shall ensure the availability and accessibility of legal aid and other forms of assistance for those who cannot afford to pursue their legal rights.

Article XVII: Right to Freedom of Movement

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to freedom of movement, and shall be free to move and reside within the territory of the Malachian Empire, subject only to the limits necessary to protect public order and security.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to freedom of movement, and shall ensure that its citizens have access to information and services related to their movement and residence, including travel documents, registration, and identification.

Article XVIII: Right to Family and Marriage

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to form and maintain a family, and shall be entitled to legal recognition and protection of their family relationships.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to family and marriage, and shall ensure equal rights and opportunities for all individuals and families, regardless of their composition or structure.

Article XIX: Right to Disability Rights

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire with disabilities shall have the right to full and effective participation in society, and shall be entitled to equal access to education, employment, health care, and other services and opportunities.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the rights of persons with disabilities, and shall ensure the accessibility and inclusiveness of all aspects of society, including the physical environment, communication, and information technology.

Article XX: Right to Freedom of Religion

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to freedom of religion, and shall be free to practice, preach, and profess their religion or belief, subject only to the limits necessary to protect the rights and freedoms of others.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to freedom of religion, and shall ensure that its citizens have equal opportunities and treatment regardless of their religion or belief.

Article XXI: Right to Child Protection

- 1. All children of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to special protection and care, and shall be entitled to equal opportunities and treatment, regardless of their gender, ethnicity, religion, or any other status.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the rights of children, and shall ensure the provision of necessary services and programs, including education, health care, and social protection, for the well-being and development of children.

Article XXII: Right to Non-Discrimination

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to non-discrimination, and shall be free from any form of discrimination based on race, ethnicity, religion, gender, disability, sexual orientation, or any other status.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to non-discrimination, and shall ensure equal opportunities and treatment for all individuals and groups in all aspects of life, including education, employment, health care, and public services.

Article XXIII: Right to Peaceful Protest

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to peaceful protest and assembly, and shall be free to express their views and opinions through peaceful means, subject only to the limits necessary to protect public order and security.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to peaceful protest, and shall ensure that its citizens can exercise this right without fear of repression, harassment, or violence.

Article XXIV: Right to Self-Identification

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to self-identify, and shall be free to determine their own identity, including their race, ethnicity, religion, gender, sexual orientation, and any other characteristic or affiliation.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to self-identification, and shall ensure that its citizens are not forced or coerced to identify in a particular way or to hide or deny their identity.
- 3. The Malachian Empire shall respect and celebrate the diversity of its citizens, and shall strive to create an inclusive and accepting society where all individuals and groups can thrive and contribute to the common good.

Article XXVII: Right to Spiritual Practices and Ceremony

- 4. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to practice their spiritual and religious beliefs, including the use of sacred medicines like DMT, ayahuasca, Kambo, Sananga, Changa, and Rapé, subject only to the limits necessary to protect public health and safety.
- 5. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to spiritual practices and ceremony, and shall ensure that its citizens have access to necessary resources and information for their spiritual and religious pursuits.
- 6. The Malachian Empire shall respect and protect the cultural heritage and traditions of its citizens, including their spiritual and religious practices, and shall not discriminate against any individual or group based on their spiritual or religious beliefs or practices.

Article XXVIII: Right to Travel without a Driver's License

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to travel without a driver's license, and shall be free to use any mode of transportation that is available and appropriate for their needs and circumstances.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to travel without a driver's license, and shall ensure that its citizens are not discriminated against or penalized for choosing not to obtain a driver's license.
- 3. The Malachian Empire shall take appropriate measures to ensure the safety and security of its citizens who travel without a driver's license, and shall provide necessary information and resources to help them travel safely and responsibly.

Article XXIX: Right to Travel Internationally with the Malachian Empire Passport

- 1. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to travel internationally with a valid Malachian Empire passport, subject only to the limits necessary to protect public order and security.
- 2. The Malachian Empire shall promote and protect the right to international travel, and shall ensure that its citizens have access to necessary travel documents, including passports and visas, and relevant information and assistance for their travel abroad.
- 3. The Malachian Empire shall take appropriate measures to ensure the safety and security of its citizens who travel internationally, and shall provide necessary consular services and assistance to its citizens in foreign countries.
