

The Malachian Constitution

Preamble:

We, the people of the Malachian Empire, united by our common faith and heritage, do hereby establish this Constitution to create a sovereign, faith-based, non-federal tribal government and micro nation called the Malachian Empire. Guided by the principles of the Malachian Faith, we pledge to uphold the dignity, rights, and liberties of all our citizens, and to work towards a just and prosperous society.

Article I: Sovereignty

1. The Malachian Empire shall be a sovereign, independent state and micro nation, recognized by the international community.
2. The Malachian Empire shall have the power to conduct foreign relations, sign treaties, and engage in diplomacy with other nations.
3. The Malachian Empire shall have the power to regulate its internal affairs, including its economy, legal system, and social policies.

Article II: The Malachian Faith

1. The Malachian Faith shall be the official religion of the Malachian Empire, and shall be protected and promoted by the government.
2. All citizens of the Malachian Empire shall have the right to practice their own religion, or to abstain from religion, without interference or discrimination.
3. The Malachian Faith shall guide the moral and ethical principles of the Malachian Empire, and shall inform its laws and policies.

Article III: The Supreme Council

3. The Malachian Empire shall promote research and innovation, and shall support scientific and technological progress for the benefit of all.

Article XII: Environment

1. The Malachian Empire shall protect the environment and natural resources, and shall promote sustainable development and conservation.
2. The Malachian Empire shall regulate and supervise activities that may harm the environment, and shall promote responsible and ethical behavior by individuals and organizations.
3. The Malachian Empire shall cooperate with other nations and international organizations to address global environmental challenges and protect the planet for future generations.

Article XIII: Amendments

1. This Constitution may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the Supreme Council.
2. Proposed amendments must be submitted in writing, and must be circulated among the tribes for review and feedback.
3. Amendments shall take effect immediately upon ratification by the Supreme Council, unless otherwise specified.

Article XIV: Supremacy of the Constitution

1. This Constitution shall be the supreme law of the Malachian Empire, and shall prevail over any other law, custom, or tradition.
